SUPERIOR COURT JUDGES.

AN ACT relating to the salaries of the Judges of the Superior Court in Class "A" counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Each judge of the superior court in class "A" counties shall receive an annual salary of six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00). Salaries.

CHAPTER 170.

[S. B. 137.]

INHERITANCE TAXES AND ESCHEATS.

AN ACT relating to inheritance taxes and escheats, and amending section 10878 of Remington's Compiled Statutes, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That Section 10878 of Remington's Compiled Statutes be amended to read as follows:

Section 10878. The director of taxation and examination shall have the power, and it shall be his duty, to exercise all the powers and perform all the duties relating to inheritance taxes and escheats, now vested in, and required to be performed by, the state tax commissioner.
