

CHAPTER 97.

NOTARIES PUBLIC.

AN ACT relating to certificates of official character of Notaries Public and amending section 10, page 476, Laws of 1889-1890, said Act being entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment, qualification and duties of Notaries Public, certifying their official acts, and declaring an emergency to exist." (Section 9909, Remington's Revised Statutes.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 10, page 476, Laws of 1889-1890, said Act being entitled "An Act to provide for the appointment, qualification and duties of Notaries Public, certifying their official acts, and declaring an emergency to exist," (section 9909, Remington's Revised Statutes) is amended to read as follows: Amendments.

Section 10. The County Clerk of the county in which such notary resides, or the Secretary of State, may grant certificates of official character of notaries public. The certificate of the Clerk shall be under his hand and official seal, and that of the Secretary of State, under the seal of the State. Certificate of official character.
