(3) All equipment acquired and used by, and Equipment all funds appropriated to, the board of prison terms transferred. and paroles for such purpose shall be transferred to the superintendent of public institutions upon the taking effect of this section.

SEC. 2. Section 5, chapter 114, Laws of 1935 and Amendment. RCW 9.95.180 are each amended to read as follows:

Whenever in its judgment the best interests of superintend-ent of public institutions the state or the welfare of any prisoner confined in institutions of the state of the s any penal institution will be better served by his transfer. transfer to another institution the superintendent of public institutions may effect such transfer.

## CHAPTER 246. [ S. B. 191.]

CRIMES-COMMITMENT TO STATE REFORMATORY. AN ACT relating to punishment for crimes and amending section 25, chapter 249, Laws of 1909 and RCW 9.92.050.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 25, chapter 249, Laws of 1909 Amendment. and RCW 9.92.050 are each amended to read as follows:

Whenever any male person, between the ages of Discretion of sixteen and thirty years, is convicted of any felony confinement in Washington the court may, in its discretion, order such person state reformatory. to be committed to and confined in the Washington state reformatory.
