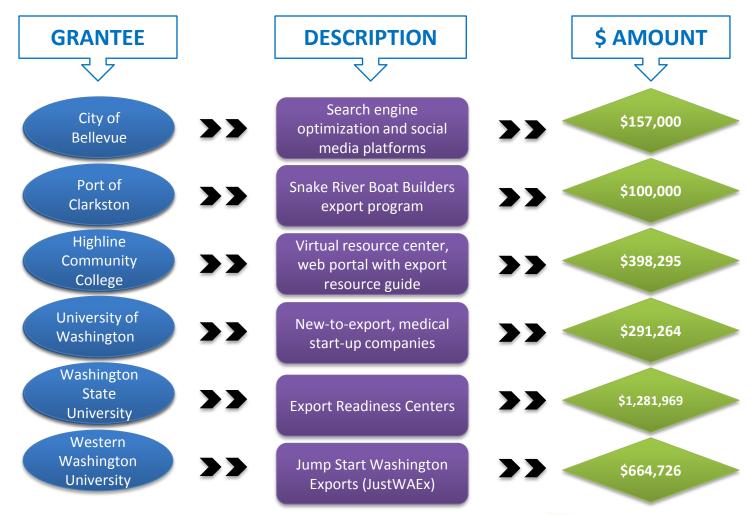

Asia Target Markets Trade Development The City of Bellevue

- **Project Description**: Creation of a business-to-business website or "export promotion portal" with foreign language content designed to market Washington products to Asian countries and to match sellers(Washington state businesses) with buyers (businesses in Asia). Businesses targeted include those in the Life Sciences, Clean Technology and Information Technology sectors.
- Number of Businesses Assisted Jan-Sept 2011: 102
 Number of New to Export Businesses Assisted Jan-Sept 2011: 11
- Project Update: Customer outreach to China (buyer side) has been added and begun - trips by Bellevue Deputy Mayor to Dalian and Joe Borich WSCTRC to Beijing, help from local experts. Bellevue also added outreach to the Venture Capital community (handful of leaders) was very productive and largely completed.



Snake River Boat Builders Export Program Port of Clarkson

- Project Description: Snake River Boat Builders Export Program is an outstanding example of cluster-based economic development. The welded-aluminum jet boat manufacturers and suppliers in southeast Washington have joined forces with local economic development organizations to promote the export of these unique boats to European markets.

- **Project Description:** Connect export-ready Washington State businesses with prospective agents, importers, and qualified businesses in the British Columbia(B.C.), other Canadian markets, and abroad. Provide buyer/seller matchmaking services, business counseling, and produce mini trade shows or summits to showcase Washington State products and services for Canadian buyers. Coordinate trainings for Washington businesses to gain more expertise in export. Implement a statewide "Companies to Watch" recognition program

- Project Description: The Washington State University Small Business
 Development Center network (WSBDC) will open two new "export
 readiness centers" intended to serve the informational needs of the
 potential and new-to-export business community.

SBA – STEP Grant for Export Promotion

- Award to WA State announced on Sept 27 \$1.6m for 12 months
- Matched with \$531,000 of state funds (CERB export training programs)
 - CERB programs provide a pipeline of export-ready companies for STEP

Our STEP Activities:

- Marketing and Outreach to promote a "Culture of Exporting" across WA
 - Create awareness of our free/low cost export assistance programs
 - Build web site www.exportwashington.com
 - Outreach for veteran, women and minority owned companies
- Export Vouchers to support SME exports
 - Up to \$5,000 per company, with 25% match
 - \$225,000 budget for vouchers



SBA – STEP Grant for Export Promotion

- China Accelerator Low-cost business incubator space in Shanghai
 - Bilingual targeted industry advisors in Shanghai
 - Assist clients with in-country representation and office space
- Europe Accelerator Targeted industry trade shows in Europe and U.S. 11 events
 - Meet with European buyers of technology products and services

Rural Accelerators:

- WSDA support for food and beverage processors in Asia and Mexico
 - \$199,094 program budget
- Commerce Companies to Watch
 - Partner with WEDA for training, mentoring and networking programs
 - \$56,426 program budget



SBA – STEP Grant for Export Promotion

- Export Finance Lender readiness, partner with EFACW
 - Outreach and training for banks in WA to increase the number that support SBA and Ex-Im Bank export finance assistance programs

Outcomes:

- Export Sales \$58 million
- New-to-Export Companies 47
- New-to-Market Companies 54

STEP Year 2:

- Applications due in March 2012
- ISSUE source of match funding
